Youth Arts Month Rotating Gallery Exhibit

Instead of a single spring exhibit, we are hosting a month-long rotating exhibit in the Clark Gallery. **This replaces F.A.M.E. and the Wabash County Elementary Art Show and Spring Banner Competition**. We will showcase artwork from Pre K – 6 students weekly throughout March. Junior High and High School students will participate in a separate exhibit in April.

- Art delivery and pick up will take place at the Honeywell Center Box Office. The Box Office is open Monday Friday 8am 5pm.
- You may choose to deliver and pick up all artwork together for convenience; Honeywell will store it before and after display.
- Final Pickup Deadline: April 7, 2025

Awards:

- Every student whose artwork is submitted will receive a **participation ribbon**.
- Ribbons will be distributed to art teachers for distribution to students.
- **No judging** will occur.

Submission Guidelines:

- Open to all Pre K 6 Wabash County students.
- Each teacher may submit **one 2-D piece** of artwork per student; however, it is not required that every student have a piece submitted.
- If binder clips are not sufficient to hang, attach a hanger to the artwork.
- No size limits, but artwork must fit Clark Gallery display capabilities.
- Label artwork on the lower right corner using Arial 24-point font for name tags.

• NO Google Form submissions are necessary.

Label: The nametag should hang from the lower right corner. For consistency, use the font "Arial" size 24. See below:
