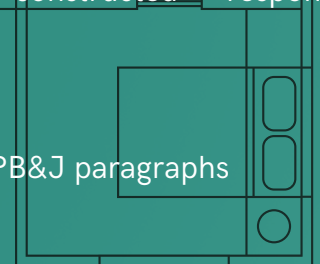
WHAT ARE CONSTRUCTED RESPONSE STRATEGIES?

Constructed response strategies help to respond to questions thoroughly. While we tend to think of this during our language arts instruction, students can use these strategies anytime they need to respond with evidence!

R.A.C.E. is a common constructed response strategy. First students RESTATE the question. Next students answer the questions. Then students CITE evidence from the text. Finally students EXPLAIN their answer.

Other popular constructed response strategies include:

- R.A.P.P.
- I.C.E.
- Hamburger or PB&J paragraphs
- Yes MA'AM
- A.C.E.
