

# Question Power

The question, "what's going on in this picture?" invites students to start making meaning based on the visual information. This question can be altered to fit your common information from text to artifacts.

The question, "what did you see that makes you say that?" reminds students to provide evidence from our visual text. This question can be adjusted to fit text... what did you read....

The question, "what more can we find?" sends students back to our visual text. This reminder can be used to keep students looking at important information.

- Use these questions when approaching a new task, such as a math model or a science experiment.
- Voice these questions when a student shows you their artwork.
- Ask these questions when students are having a disagreement.
